LOCAL RULES & INFORMATION

Out of Bounds

- Defined by white stakes or fences

Ground under Repair

The temporary greens and areas defined by blue stakes or white lines are GUR: the player must take relief in accordance with rule 25-1.

Water Hazard

- hole 17 - the lake behind the green is defined as a lateral water hazard: the dropping zone may be used as an additional option if the ball cannot be dropped in accordance with R. 26-1c.
- hole 18 - water hazard (lake between green and tee): if it is not possible to proceed in accordance with R. 26-1c, a dropping zone may be used as an additional option.

Obstructions

- All roads & paths are integral part of the course.
- Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (R. 24-1).
- All stakes (blue, red, yellow, green, brown & distance markers) and ropes are immovable obstructions (rule 24-2).
- The wire fences on the right hand side of hole 2 are immovable obstructions (rule 24-2).
- Trees identified by stakes: if such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty and dropped in accordance with rule 24-2-b (i).

Temporary Local Rules

See ad valvas if any Temporary Local Rules are in operation.

Breach of Local Rules

- in stroke play: 2 penalty strokes
- in match play: loss of hole

Distance Stakes

Green: 100 m center green
White-green: 150 m center green

Fairway Markers

White: 200 m front green
Yellow: 150 m front green
Red: 100 m front green

Field Crops

The crops in the adjoining fields must be respected. Any ball coming to rest in these fields must be abandoned ("lost ball") unless it can be recovered without any damage to the crops.

Holes 3 & 17 - Bells

Use the bells! Wait for the bell before you approach green of hole 3 or driving from tee 17.

Path green

17 to tees 18 - Safety
Do not re-cross bridge on green 17. In order to avoid dangerous play, slow play and subsidence, it is compulsory to proceed to the 18th tees along the path between the stream and the pond, through the bridge of hole 18.
